

CBCV Introduction

The Club Brevinois de Char à Voile (CBCV) has been created in November 2016 to complete the sand yachting offer on the Saint Brevin site.

Two structures were already existing: the Centre Nautique de Saint Brevin (CNSB) and Eole Karting Sensations (EKS), both specialized in offering training and discovery sand yachting sessions for schoolchildren and the general public.

CBCV aim to:

- o Gather member sand yachters from any skill level,
- o Represent sand yachting pilots in Saint Brévin council discussions,
- o Represent sand yachting pilots in French sand yachting Federation (FFCV)
- o Organize "discovery and promotional" sand yachting events
- o Organize and develop sand yachting practicing, from the basics to the highest competition levels,
- o Organize local, national and international races or championships.

After 3 years life, CBCV has 70 members, half of them are competitors with numerous titles and performance rankings in national and international races.

We usually set up 3 or 4 regional, national and international yearly competitions.
